Please use this document as a quick guide to reference how to join NESA Programs and Events via Zoom for Government Meeting.

Access the Zoom Meeting Link from the NESA Center

Check your email or the provided document for the Meeting Link from the NESA Center. Then click on the **Link** to access the meeting. It is recommended, for optimal performance, to use the browsers Google Chrome or Mozilla Firefox. Please make sure the browser used is up to date with the most current version installed.

To open Zoom via an application, click on "Open Zoom.us." If you do not already have the application installed on your device, you may be prompted to download the application at this time. It is also available for manual download here.

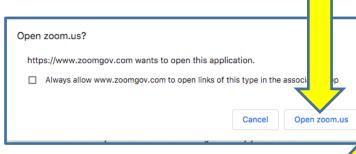

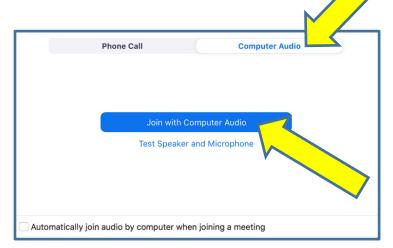

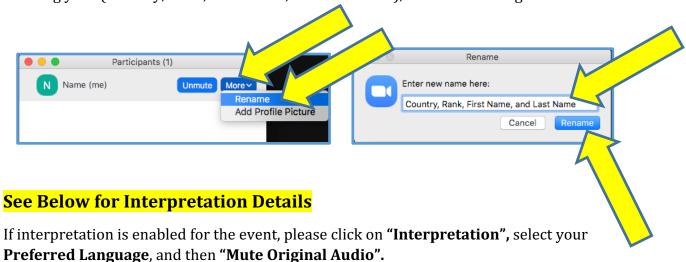
Select "Computer Audio" and "Join with Computer Audio".

Click on "Participants". Select "More" and then "Rename". Enter your new name by entering your (Country, Rank, First Name, and Last Name), and then clicking "Rename".
